- 2. How many years did Abraham have to wait for the initial fulfillment of God's promise? From Genesis 22:1-24, what was Abraham willing to give up to believe God's promise?
- 3. According to Hebrews 6:13-14 and 17-18, what did God do to demonstrate the certainty of His promise?
- 4. In Hebrews 6:18, what do the people of God do in response to the trustworthiness of God?
- 5. From 1 Peter 3-9, what is the hope believers are to anticipate? How does that hope anchor the soul? Why would that have encouraged Christians who were being persecuted for their faith?
- 6. What secures the believer's confidence and hope according to Hebrews 6:20, and why? How can you praise God for the hope given in Jesus?
