An Example to be Followed

Read Hebrews chapter 6:1-20

1. In Hebrews 6:13, the author uses Abraham as an example of someone who trusted God. From Genesis 12:1-3 and Genesis 15, what was God's promise to Abraham?
2. How many years did Abraham have to wait for the initial fulfillment of God's promise? From Genesis 22:1-24, what was Abraham willing to give up to believe God's promise?
3. According to Hebrews 6:13-14 and 17-18, what did God do to demonstrate the certainty of His promise?
4. In Hebrews 6:18, what do the people of God do in response to the trustworthiness of God?
5. From 1 Peter 3-9, what is the hope believers are to anticipate? How does that hope anchor the soul? Why would that have encouraged Christians who were being persecuted for their faith?
6. What secures the believer's confidence and hope according to Hebrews 6:20, and why? How can you praise God for the hope given in Jesus?
