

Hebrews 7:26-28 (February 22, 2026)

- I. Jesus is a Superior High Priest according to a **Better Order** (7:1-10)
- II. Jesus is a Perfect High Priest who brings a **Better Hope** (7:11-19)
- III. Jesus is a Divinely Confirmed High Priest who guarantees a **Better Covenant** (7:20-22)
- IV. Jesus is a Permanent High Priest who performs a **Better Ministry** (7:23-25)
- V. Jesus is a Consummate High Priest who accomplished a **Better Work** (7:26-28)

Questions:

- 1. Read through Jesus' high priestly prayer in John 17. What particularly encourages you regarding His prayers for His people?
- 2. What confidence does the eternal priesthood of Jesus give the believer according to Romans 8:31-39?
- 3. According to Hebrews 7:26, what about Jesus' person makes Him the kind of priest we need?

4. Use your study Bible, a Bible commentary or some other Bible resource to define each of the terms listed in 7:26. What encourages you about these truths?
5. From Hebrews 7:26-28, how is Jesus' priestly work different than the Levitical priests? (See Hebrews 5:1-3; 9:11-14; and 10:11-14)
6. What is significant about the fact that Jesus is "exalted above the heavens" (7:26); and what does that mean for us? (See also Hebrews 4:14 and 8:1-2)
7. What contrast is re-emphasized in Hebrews 7:28, and how does it summarize the truth of Hebrews 7?
