2. According to Hebrews 9:15, why did man need the new covenant?
3. What does it mean to be “called” by God in this context? See also Romans 8:28-30 and 1 Corinthians 1:23-24.
4. If you have believed on the Lord Jesus Christ for salvation, what has been promised to you?
5. Read Exodus 24:3-8 for context. According to Hebrews 9:16-21, what is necessary for the inauguration of a covenant?
6. According to Leviticus 5:11 and Hebrews 9:22, what does it mean that almost all things are cleansed with blood?
7. How does Leviticus 17:11 inform your understanding of the connection between blood and forgiveness in Hebrews 9:22
8. Find 3 or 4 references in the New Testament that address the shedding of Christ’s blood for the salvation of sinners. How does that truth motivate you to live, think, speak, and worship in response?
